 - ✓ Decision 3/CMP.12, paragraph 9

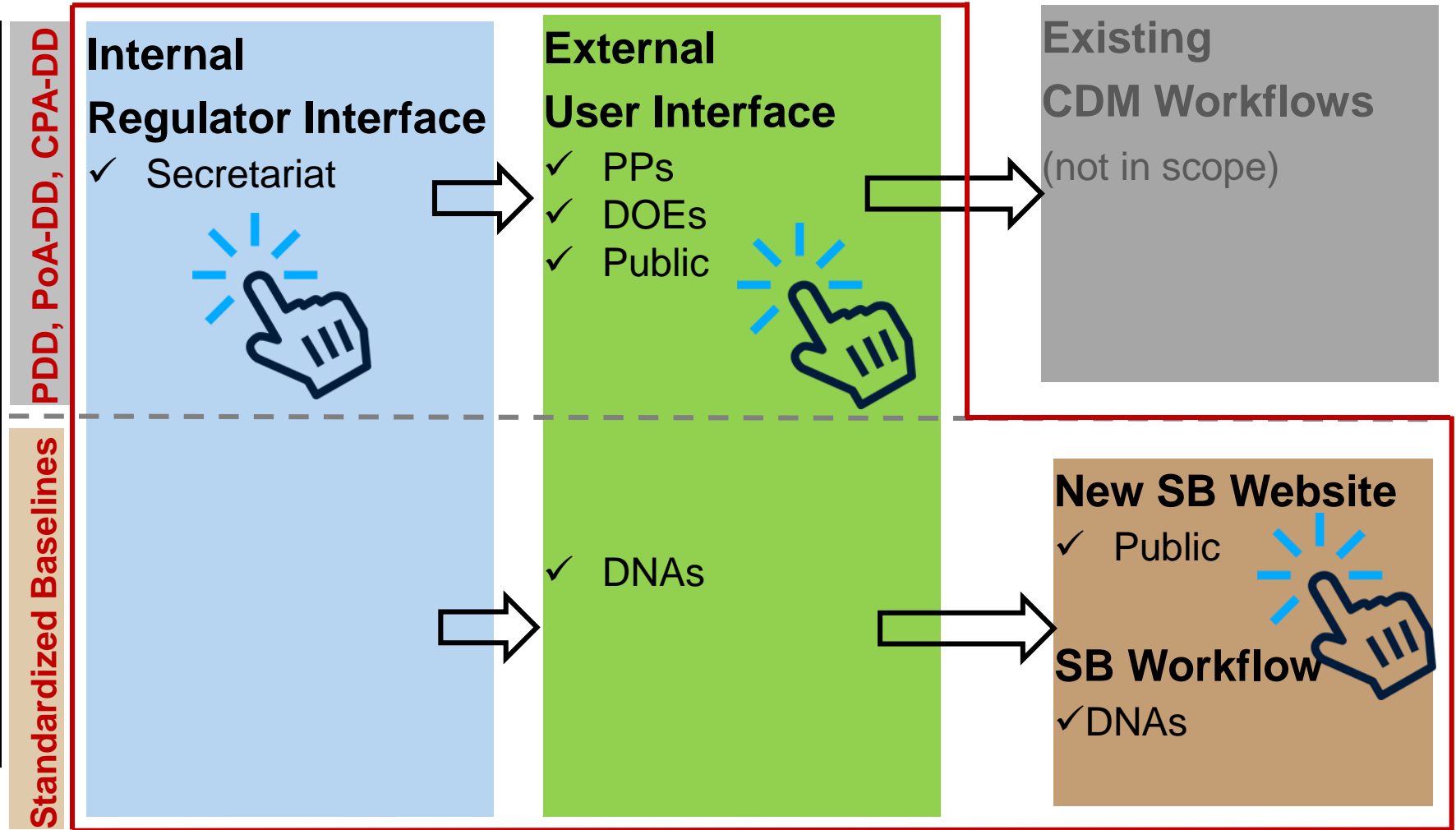


Purpose

Solution: overview of the components of the system





Benefits of the tool

- ✓ **Complexity** to develop CDM Projects, PoA/CPA-DD and Standardized Baselines (SBs) **is significantly reduced** for PPs and DNAs (less worries about the maze of methodologies/tools/guidelines)
- ✓ Lower formulation and **transaction costs** for Projects, PoA/CPA-DD and SBs
- ✓ **Improved user experience** for stakeholders (PPs, DNAs, etc.): default values set in advance, pre-defined options, automated selections, questions asked once, etc.
- ✓ **High degree of flexibility and agility**, as questionnaires and associated components can be dynamically changed to reflect in a prompt manner, the evolution of the methodologies/tools approved by the Board
- ✓ Enhanced **quality of submissions** (validity and consistency checks)
- ✓ **Facilitation of project validation and assessment**
- ✓ Projects' data capture for use as **benchmarks or data analysis** purposes to improve methodologies/tools, etc.
- ✓ **Auditability** (Tree view and Excel export of questionnaires)
